  - a. Google working conditions, watch <u>Top 10 Cool Benefits At The Heavenly</u> Google

#### **Discussion Questions:**

- i. What kind of working conditions do they have at Google?
- ii. Do you think the employee benefits motivates the employees to work?
- iii. Would you consider working for a job at Google? Why?
- b. Amazon working conditions, watch <u>Ex-Amazon workers talk of</u> 'horrendous' conditions

#### **Discussion Questions:**

- i. What kind of working conditions do they have at Amazon?
- ii. Would you consider working at Amazon? Explain why.
- iii. Do you think the employees at Amazon should have better working conditions? Explain why.
- iv. If you were a boss at Amazon, which working condition (pay, hours, lunch break....) would you change first to encourage your employees to stay in your company? Explain your answer.
- v. After having seen this video, will you think twice before ordering from Amazon? Explain your answer.
