Role of the Employer

Role of the Student

The WOTP uses the work-study approach to give students the opportunity to develop their employability skills.

During the practicum students are expected to develop specific competencies (from the Directory of Semiskilled Trades) and adopt attitudes and behaviours required in the workplace.



Role of the School
