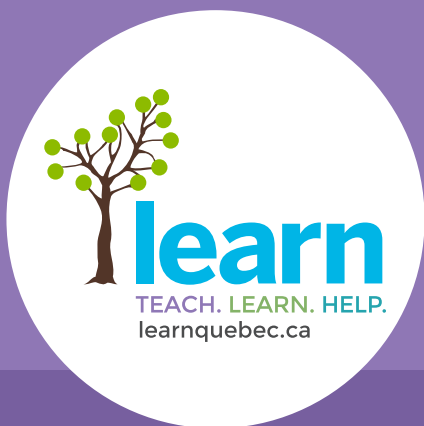


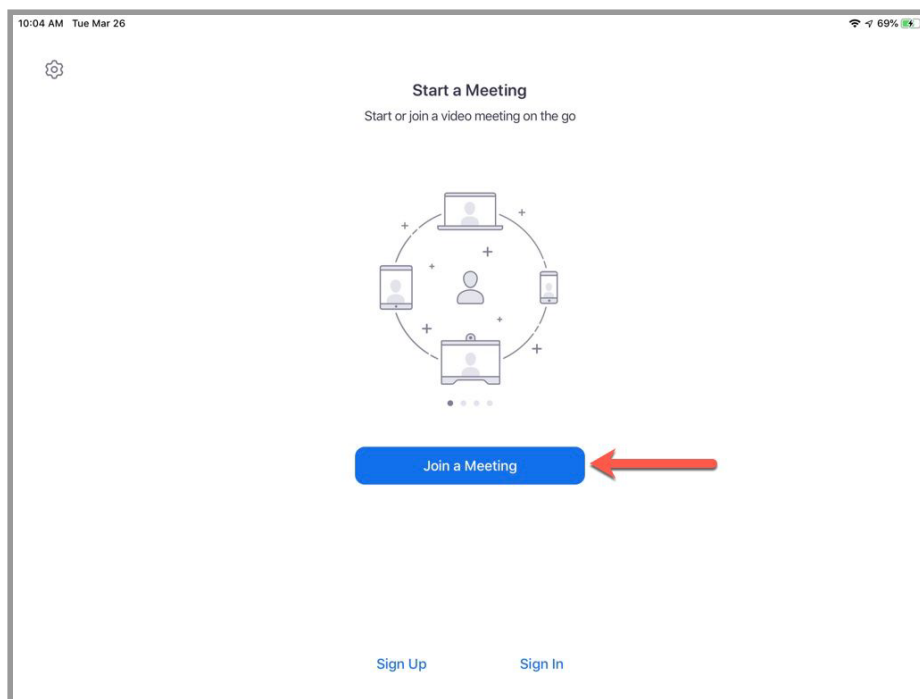
Zoom for iPad Quick Start Guide



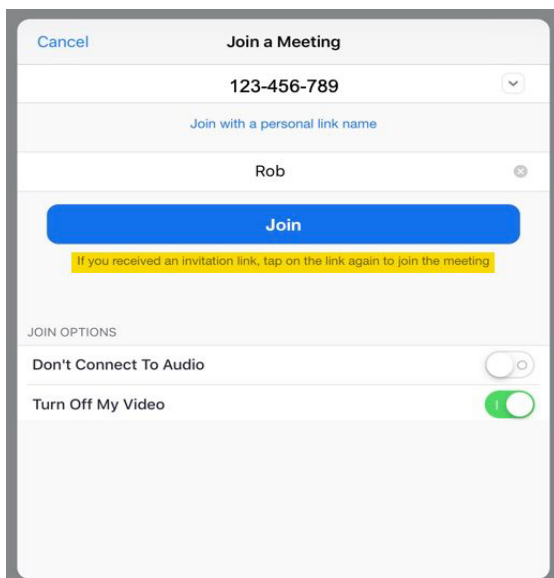
ONLINE SOLUTIONS FOR STUDENTS

Start by [downloading the Zoom app](#) for your iPad.

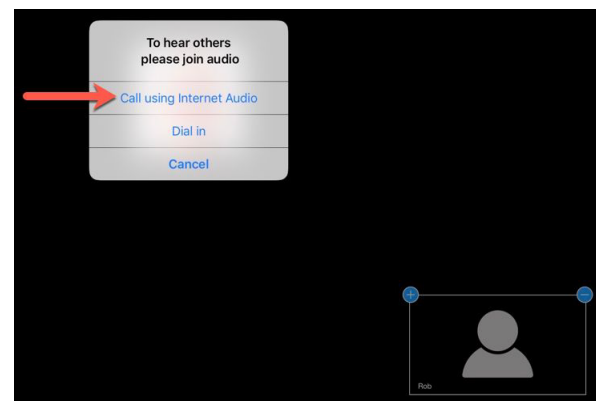
1. From the email on your iPad, click on the link provided OR copy and paste it into your browser toolbar.
2. Zoom will start to launch. Please **CLICK** on Join a Meeting.



3. Follow the instructions:

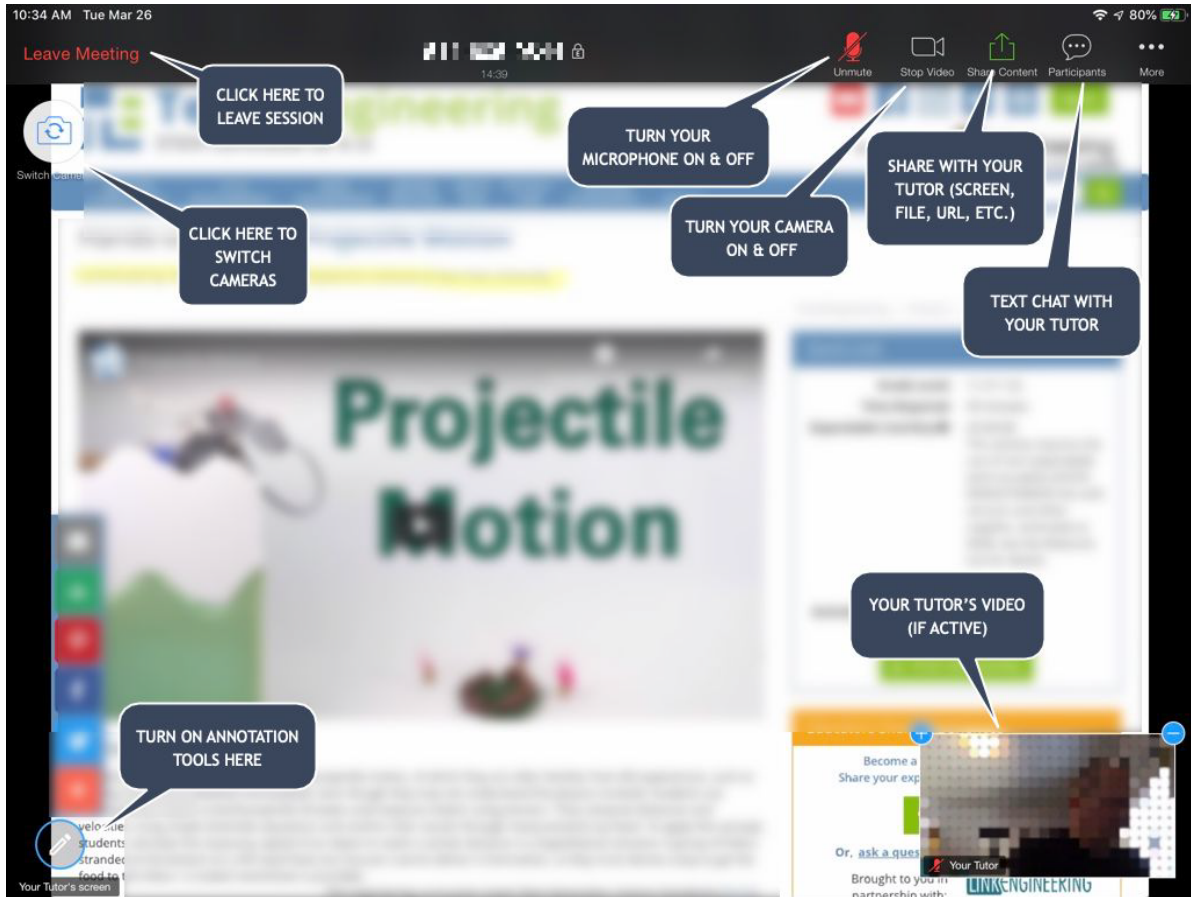


4. Now select **Call using Internet Audio** to hear the tutor when you join the meeting.

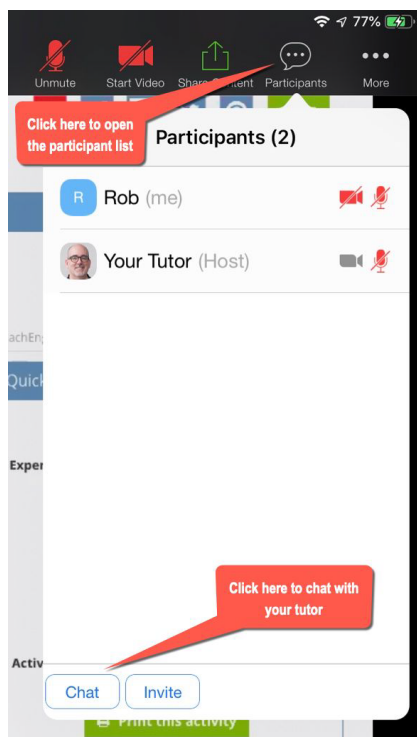

Participants:

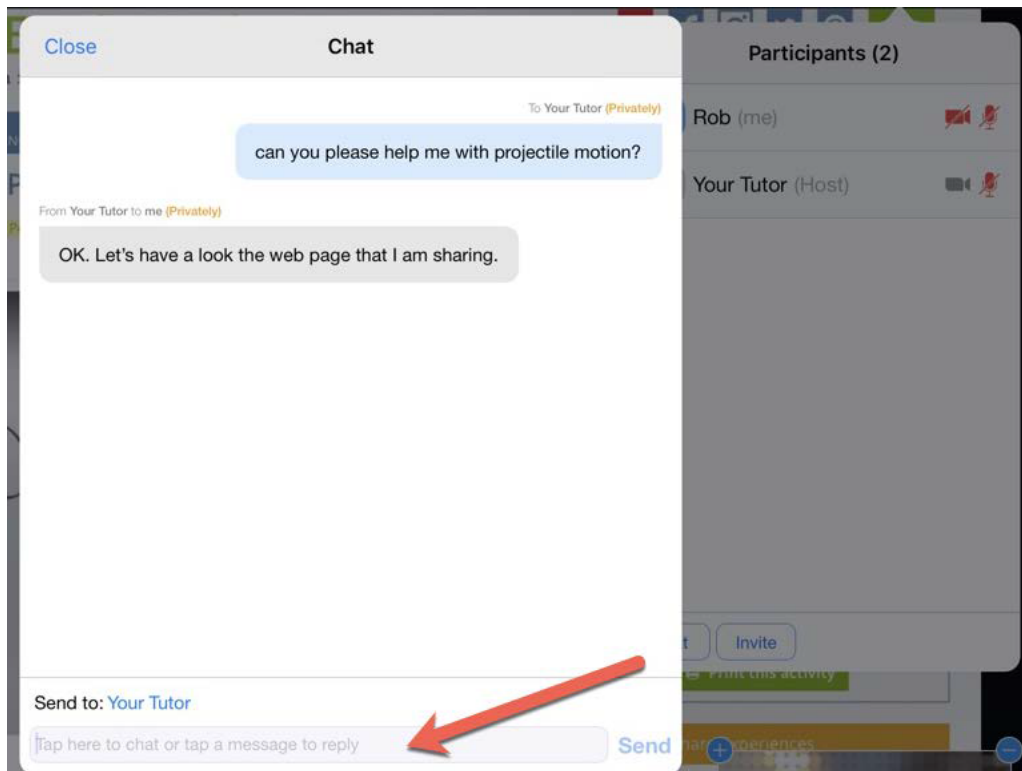


Always click on the **Participants** and **Chat** icons when you enter Zoom.

The participants list gives you access to quick feedback icons.

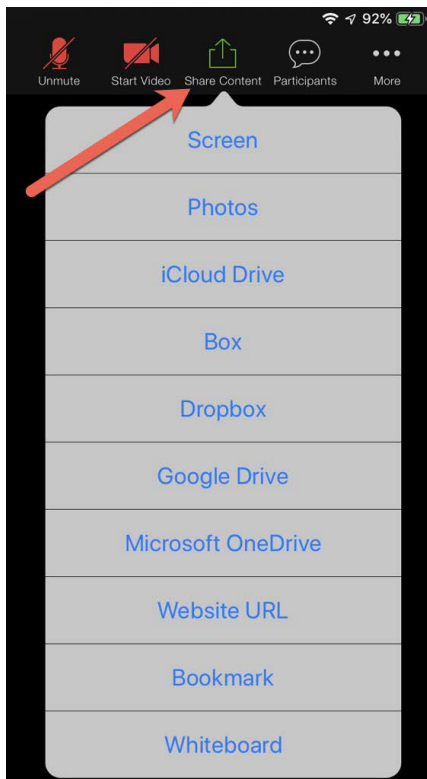
Opening up the chat box will allow you to chat with your teacher.

You can chat with your teacher and classmates using the chat feature.

Zoom enables you to share your screen as well as various kinds of documents.

Your responsibilities as an online student

The effectiveness of online classes and meetings depends on your positive participation. Here are some helpful tips:

- Arrive online on time, properly equipped with required books and papers.
- Concentrate – do not allow disruptions by others and do not disturb other students.
- Keep up with homework and assignments.
- If you encounter difficulties with course content, inform your teacher so that you can get extra support.
- If you must miss a scheduled class, inform your teacher in advance, whenever possible.
- Participate in every class but do not take up all of the “air time”.

Use of the Internet:

- Respect confidentiality – never use other people’s codes, files or passwords without permission.
- Do not use social media for personal use during class time as this breaks your concentration on the lesson being taught.
- A private chat feature in Zoom permits you to communicate directly with your teacher. Use this tool when you feel that there is a need for private teacher support.
- Downloading and having multiple tabs and windows open may cause audio transmission speed to slow down.
- While there may be times to turn on webcams during class, it is not recommended that they be left on constantly as bandwidth may be impacted negatively.
- Online class spaces are for educational purposes. Students misusing the platforms may be removed.
